How to Care for Your Tree

Stages of Growth

SEEDLING: developing and sprouting tree

SAPLING: young tree, which is growing rapidly

MATURITY: fully grown tree / tree in reproductive stage

OLD AGE: tree, which is no longer growing / produces less pollen and fewer seeds

Tree Maintenance and Care

Process	Frequency	Stage of life	Benefits
Pruning	Monthly and when needed	# Sapling # Maturity # Old age	# Safety # Aesthetics # Increasing air flow and sunlight exposure
Mulching	Annually or when needed	# Seedling # Sapling # Maturity # Old age	# Weed control # Soil insulation # Aesthetics # Better overall tree health
Root Fertilization	Once in 2 years	# Maturity	# Better nutrient absorption # Healthier growth # Supporting beneficial fungi and microorganisms
Bracing and Cabling	When needed	# Seedling # Old age	# Safety # Directional growth # Support for unstable branches or trunk
Tree and Stump Removal	When needed	# Old age	# Safety # Aesthetics
