What is Mission Northeast?

Our mission is to "change our community, one life at a time, through the love of Jesus Christ"

We began as a small church pantry in Kingwood in 1995, and in 2000 we moved to our own free-standing location on Loop 694 in New Caney.

In addition to providing food, clothing and household items, we also build relationships with our clients by getting to know them and helping them above and beyond their basic needs. Non-denominational chapel services are offered in the morning and we provide Bibles and study materials upon request. Our other programs and services include: Care partners for each client family; job training and a jobs ministry; Adult GED and ESL classes onsite; Thanksgiving and Christmas distributions; monthly home delivery of food and other assistance for senior and disabled persons; Mission Possible (a summer learning and skills program for children); a site for Project Mammogram; the site for Feed My Lambs (a lunch delivery program for the needy); and many other forms of outreach that grow as needs and opportunities arise.

All of our programs and services are provided free of charge without consideration of age, race, ethnicity, sex, or religious preference.

Our Adult Education Program provides opportunities for education/job skills training and employment that help move families out of poverty. Our Jobs Ministry includes a job board that is updated daily and two Job Fairs each year.

Thanksgiving and Christmas are very special! Community food and toy drives make the holidays brighter for hundreds of families. We have a Christmas party for our senior adults, and are the only agency that also provides gifts for children to give their parents or caregivers.

- 97% of our families are categorized as "extremely poor"
- Many homes are headed by grandparents raising grandchildren
- Approximately 75% of our families are elderly and/or disabled
- Families may be victims of job loss; death of spouse or parent; fire; flood; abandonment; domestic violence; and some are homeless. Sometimes people just need a little extra hope and help to get through a hard time.
