Before diving with sharks, gather some info.

- 1. Search for a dive buddy.**
Any location with good diving has one or more dive shops. These shop professionals know the sites and the best weather. Don't argue.

2. Check the weather.
Some important questions to know are: How is it storm regularly? Are there too storms often in this location?

3. Let your diver know if you are a beginner.
On your First dive it is better to go with a dive master.

4. Listen carefully!
Before the dive, the dive master will tell you should not do:

 - 1) WHERE YOU WILL ENTER IN RELATION TO THE SITE
 - 2) WHERE YOU WILL BE GOING HOW LONG YOU WILL BE UNDER
 - 3) WHAT THE MAX DEPTH WILL BE
 - 4) WHAT GEARING YOU WILL USE
 - 5) WHAT TO DO IF YOU NEED TO LEAVE THE DIVE
 - 6) WHAT SITES YOU WILL SEE AND
 - 7) HOW LONG A SAFETY STOP YOU WILL DO IF IT
