With his pencil "Ambrogio" (the crocodile mascot for "Inter F.C."), "Zigo" (the dog mascot for "Hellas-Verona F.C.") and the eagle trademark for "Alpitour TNT volley team of Cuneo, took shape. "Alex" (the mascot for "Juventus F.C.") and "Dudy" (the devil mascot for "Milan F.C") were restylings of existing designs. Currently, the artist is in contact with Peter Gabriel's "Real World" on a new project.

Another important job is the complete range of over 250 handpainted illustrations helped with Photoshop, for a PC game called "The Iron Mask" published at the end of 1999 by Medialab for the Italian market.

This job was the start of a new career as cartoonist.




