All the units include daily outdoor activities, music and movement, literacy arts, cookery lessons, science experiments, and art and craft.

Week I: 21 Nov – 25 Nov



"Soaring High With Kites"
Combining the study of science, art, and culture, this unit introduces the children to the fascinating world of kites. The children will investigate concepts such as weather/wind, best materials to make a kite and what makes kites fly. The cultural importance of kites around the world and their influence on the development of flight will also be discussed. Language arts activities include learning about parts of the kite and different types of kites. The unit concludes with a kite-flying trip to the West Coast Park. There will be a \$5 transportation charge.

Week II: 28 Nov – 2 Dec



"All About Orang Utan"
The children will learn about the "man of the forest" - its anatomy, diet, behavior and social habits, communication and vocalization, habitat, natural enemies, etc. This unit concludes with a field trip to the Singapore Zoo.

There will be a \$5 transportation charge. Also, regular zoo admission charges apply.

Week III: 5 - 9 Dec



"Bread, Glorious Bread!"
Using the classic story, The Little Red Hen, as a provocation tool, the children will learn about good character skills that are stressed in the story such as responsibility, kindness, determination, and how they can be applied in our daily lives.

Other topics that will be explored include the different types of bread, the process of bread making related concept such as "what is yeast?", etc. This unit concludes with a visit to a bakery. There will be a \$5 transportation charge.

Week IV: 12 – 16 Dec



"Let There Be Light.... And Shadows!"
In this unit, the children will investigate shadows indoors and outdoors to develop their understanding of the sun as a light source and how it's apparent motion across the sky changes the size and direction of the shadows formed. By playing and experimenting with it, they learn about the importance of light. There will be a \$5 transportation charge.

Week V: 19 – 23 Dec



"Seeds"
One of the most popular science units in kindergarten classrooms, this unit introduces the children to some early concepts about plants and seeds. Questions such as "What is a seed?", "How do seeds travel?", "What do seeds need to grow?", "In what direction do seeds grow?", and "The importance of the root system?" will be answered. This unit concludes with a visit to a nursery. There will be a \$5 transportation charge.
