

The Hawaiian Islands are temperate year round with peak travel season December thru April. The very best time to see Hawaii is during the transition period between the dry season and the wet season: April and May or September and October.

There are several companies in Hawaii that have incredible experience in handling destination weddings. They can typically handle all of the planning including filing papers, arranging a minister, and coordinating vendors.

Hawaii does not observe daylight savings time. In fact, Hawaii has its own time zone known as Hawaiian Standard Time. Since Hawaii is a mere 20 degrees north of the equator, the islands experience near 12 hour days all year with the sun rising and setting around 6:30 local time.

Tipping standards in Hawaii are in general the same as in the continental United States. When staying in a hotel

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ISTANBUL

SPANNING THE TWO CONTINENTS OF EUROPE AND ASIA, HOME TO A POPULATION OF MORE THAN 14 MILLION PEOPLE, AND WITH ENOUGH HISTORICAL SITES TO KEEP ANY PERSON BUSY FOR SEVERAL LIFETIMES, İSTANBUL IS AS STUNNINGLY BEAUTIFUL AS IT IS UNIQUE.

Bringing together elements from Byzantine, Greek, Roman, Ottoman and Turkish civilizations, Istanbul has evolved over centuries into a city of great cultural significance. As well as its popular historical and religious sites, the city has a wide range of contemporary museums, art galleries and musical talent. The energy and creative spirit is palpable.

Istanbul is a city of extreme contrasts. From the fabulously wealthy to the very poor; the traditionalist to the liberal; from glitzy shopping malls to backstreet markets, Istanbul encompasses the good, the bad and the very beautiful.

And beautiful it surely is. Sprawling across four different waterways, Istanbul is literally surrounded by water, making it the perfect place to explore by boat. Whether you wish to cross from Europe to Asia, to cruise along the Golden Horn or Bosphorus Strait and onto the Black Sea, or to visit the Princes' Islands or the nearby city of Bursa on the Sea of Marmara, there's no more refreshing way to see the city.

Sultanahmet is at the historical heart of the city on the Eminönü Peninsula and is where most visitors come to experience some of history's most famous sites including Hagia Sophia, the Blue Mosque and the Hippodrome.

Opposite Eminönü on the Golden Horn is Beyoğlu, the modern entertainment centre of Istanbul, while on the other side of the Bosphorus lies the equally intriguing and less visited Asian side of Istanbul, which includes the suburbs of Kadıköy and Üsküdar.

Turkey follows GMT +2 hours. Though the water in Istanbul is chlorinated, it's recommended that visitors drink bottled water.

Turkish Lira is the official currency of Turkey. Note that the exchange rate in Turkey works out to be around US\$1 = 1.50 TL and €1 = 1.92 TL.

Maldives has deep blue seas, turquoise reefs, white sandy beaches and palm trees. The Maldives lies in two rows of atolls in the Indian Ocean, just across the equator. The country is made up of 1,190 coral islands formed around 26 natural ring-like atolls, spread over 90,000 square kilometers. These atoll structures are formed upon a sharp ridge rising from the ocean, making way for their secluded uniqueness.

Ninety nine percent of the Maldives is made up of sea. The people of the islands are widely dispersed across the atolls, with about 200

inhabited islands. About 90 islands are developed as tourist resort and the rest are uninhabited or used for agriculture and other livelihood purposes.

The weather in the Maldives is usually picture perfect: sunlit days, breezy nights, balmy mornings, and iridescent sunsets. The temperature hardly ever changes - which makes packing for your holiday an easy task (see what to pack). With the average temperature at about 30 degrees Celsius throughout the year, the sun is a constant on most days, shining through treetops, creating lacy patterns on your feet, healing cold bones with its warmth.

The monetary unit is the UAE Dirham (AED) divided into 100 fils. The currency is pegged to the US Dollar at a rate of US \$= AED 3.67. However US\$ is accepted as a currency and form of payment in many outlets and hotels.

Tipping practices in Dubai are comparable to most places throughout the rest of the world. Some restaurants may include a service charge on top of the bill; otherwise a tip of 10 per cent of the bill is the norm. For luggage porters at airports a tip of Dh5 or Dh10 is standard, depending on the amount of luggage.



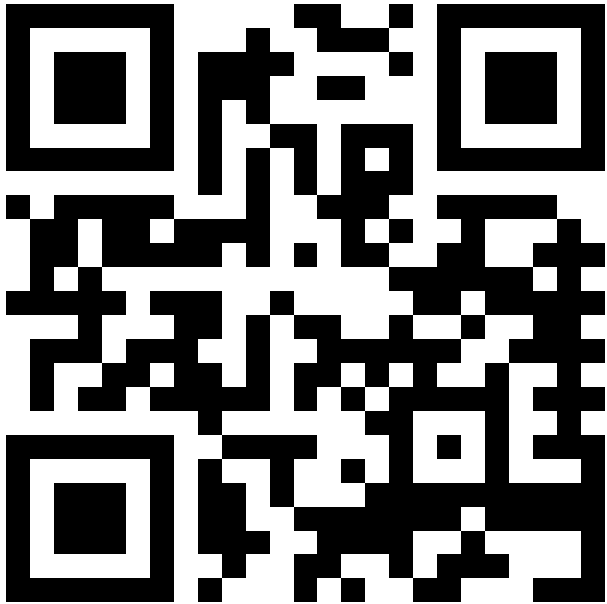
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
