Coupon and Promo Codes and How Do They Work

If you've ever used coupons at the grocery store, you're familiar with the routine. You clip coupons from newspapers and periodicals, take them to the store, and use them to gain price restrictions on specified items. The store has a problem when the clerk accepts the coupon. The Couponing Procedure
